

## SAFTEY IN AN AIR RAID

Are you in need of somewhere to shelter during an air raid? Yes? Then follow this simple guide on what to do in an air raid.

### SHELTERS:

In an air raid it is VITAL to have a shelter there are Anderson shelters which are metal shelters in your back garden at prices of £7.00. These should be dug into the ground and don't forget to put soil on the top. If you want you can grow food on the roof.

### GAS ATTACK:

In the event of a gas attack the A.R.P warden will come around waving a clicking flag. If you hear this flag you must move to a shelter IMMEDIATELY wearing your gas mask. Top tip put on your child's mask first and then yourself. Put on gloves as well to protect you from mustard gas which burns skin horribly.



### REFUGE ROOM:

A refuge room is a big room that you would choose to be your refuge room. If you have a coal cellar, choose that to be your refuge room you would move all precious belongings in there and something to do.

### WHAT TO DO WHEN YOUR HEAR THE SIREN:

You should move to the nearest shelter calmly and quickly if its clicks then put your gas mask on immediately and turn off any light that is on in your house and if you are at home do the same and get into your shelter.

### PROTECTING YOUR HOME:

If you are at home during an air raid you need to protect your home. Place tape on your windows to prevent the glass falling in to the room you're sleeping in. Put soil barricades at your front door and put a bookshelf full of heavy books on by the window. Don't forget to blackout!
